The crucial role of an independent (internal) audit function

Dutch financial supervisory legislation emphasizes the importance of an internal control or audit function.

In some cases, such as with AML/CFT regulations, having such a function is only required if proportional to the **nature and size** of the institution.

Accordingly, smaller financial organisation usually do not have their own internal control or audit function. Although this legislation does not further define or elaborate on that function, it is evident that an effective (internal) control or audit function is essential for demonstrable compliance.

What do regulators think?

The **AFM** and **DNB** also emphasize the importance of an independent audit function. 'Independence' here means objective and detached from the business. According to the AFM and DNB, this is an ongoing process that considers changing internal and external circumstances, new products, services, and supporting processes. Both regulators state that outsourced activities also fall within the scope of an (internal) audit function.
